Information on JUKKOKUTOGE

Jukkokutoge, also known as Higaneyama was registered as the 'Registered Monuments' of Cultural Properties in March, 2016. Moreover, Jukkokutoge Cable Car celebrated its 60th business anniversary on Sunday, October 16, 2016.



What is Jukkokutoge?

Jukkokutoge literary means *Ten Countries Pass*. The name of the pass comes from ten ancient provinces of Japan; 'Izu', 'Suruga', 'Totomi', 'Kai', 'Shinano', 'Sagami', 'Musashi', 'Kazusa', 'Shimousa' and 'Awa' were able to observe from the pass. Those ancient provinces are Shizuoka, Yamanashi, Kanagawa, Tokyo and Chiba in present. On the sunny day, superb views of Mt.Fuji, Minami Alps, Sagami Bay, Boso Peninsula and of course Suruga Bay can be observed from the top of Jukkokutoge.
